On Madison Avenue, **Michael Kors** expands his empire to 790 at the corner of 67th Street. Watchmaker **Vacheron Constantin** is taking the shop now occupied by David Yurman at 729 who is moving to 712. **DeLaneau of Genève** will have its stateside entry at no 681, showcasing its unique timepieces.

On Fifth Avenue, **Emanuel Ungaro** moves into the Plaza Retail Collection. Meanwhile Japanese **Uniqlo** takes over the former home of Brooks Brothers at 53rd Street.

On The Upper West Side, there has been a change of plans – **Urban Outfitters** is now at 2625 Broadway in lieu of the Metro Theater as previously reported.

In Flatiron, jeweler **Old Hollywood** joins the Limelight Marketplace as the only 'gem' in the three-storey retail complex so far.

In Midtown, **Esprit** launched its monolithic flagship at 25 West 34th Street and it is the dawn of **Desigual** at the corner of Fifth Avenue at 34th Street. **Target** is to have a **Zac Posen** 'pop' shop in Herald Square at the corner of Eighth Avenue.

In SoHo, Madrid's **Tienda Tierra** takes 65 Spring Street. The bilevel store at 109 Prince Street will become **Rugby by Ralph Lauren**. While **Chanel** is renovating 139 Spring Street, it has set up shop at 134 Spring Street. **Mascaro** is moving into a larger space at 430 West Broadway, a few doors from its existing digs, number 436. The **Jérôme Dreyfuss** boutique has finally debuted at 473 Broome Street and next door finds his wife **Isabel Marant** at 469 Broome Street.

In the West Village, **Pinky Otto** is poised for 330 Bleecker Street. In Tribeca, **Grown & Sewn** denim is at 184 Duane Street, between

Hudson & Greenwich Streets. Hailing from Japan, **Bit'z Kids** is expanding downtown to 275 Greenwich Street.

Trend-tracking from the streets of gold:

Outer-borough overtake – **Barney's Co-op** arrives at Cobble Hill Brooklyn, 194 Atlantic Avenue near Court Street and next door to Trader Joe's.
